Helpers Information

Doyalson Wyee Soccer Club operates the canteen, as well as a barbeque, on a weekly basis and requires the help of parents from each of our teams. The profit from the sale of foods assists in meeting the increasing costs of running the Club. This is generally our only source of income.

Saturday Canteen Roster

Teams with home games will be rostered for canteen duty.

Most teams will have only need to do, 2 or 3 stints of canteen duty over the whole season. We usually run the canteen from 8.00 am till the last game of the day which will vary from week to week.

Sunday Canteen Roster

Teams with home games will be rostered on for canteen duty. Canteen duty is spread out over the first three teams and those teams will only run the canteen after their own game, this saves volunteers being around for only a short time during the day.



- Last game please help pack the grounds up this includes the junior fields.
- Each team manager will be provided with time and day allocations and it is up to the manager to organize the parent roster.
- It is MOST important that parents be available to assist. If for some unforeseen reason that you are unable to attend your canteen duties, at the last minute, please inform our canteen co-coordinator. One person in the canteen and two on the barbeque are usually enough.

If your team does not turn up for their allocated time, or swap with another team it is possible that your next home game will be forfeited, please don't make it come to this option.

Due to OH&S no person under the age of 16 years is permitted to work in the canteen or on the BBQ.

Seniors Raffle Roster

Senior raffles are each Saturday night from 5pm – 7pm during March to Aug/Sept.

Each Senior team will be given a roster for their contribution during the season. The team with the highest amount raised at the end of the season will be given \$200.00.

If you are unable as a team to support your allocated night, it is your responsibility to swap with another team well in advance.

Each week participants are asked to provide their availability for the following week, so we can schedule games – If you play on Saturday mornings check your availability to referee.

Participants are paid from \$6 to \$10 a game, depending on the age group

All participants will be provided a set of rules

WWCC (Working with Children Check) - guidelines

Please note that there has been a change in the exemption rule regarding WWCC with Football NSW, so in the interests of promoting child safety within the sport of Football, the Board of Football NSW has implemented a policy which will expand the categories of individuals requiring the NSW Government's Working with Children Check (WWCC).

ALL Volunteer parents or close relatives coaching or managing their own child's or close relative's team, will now require a WWC number.

Persons aged under 18 years, even if they fall within the above categories, remain exempt.

Code of Conduct Policy 2019

Any Player / Spectator / Coach / Parent or Official or any Person present at a match or otherwise involved in any activity staged or sanctioned by DWSC/CCF or its member clubs must always:

1. Conduct yourself in a manner that enhances the reputation and goodwill of football on the Central Coast.
2. Respect the decisions of match officials & teach children to do the same.
3. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, race, colour, religion, language, politics, national, or ethnic origin.
4. Not engage in discrimination, harassment, or abuse in any form, including the use of obscene or offensive language or gestures, the incitement of hatred or violence or partaking in indecent or racist chanting.
5. Not use violence in any form, whether it is against other spectators, Team Officials (including coaches) Match Officials or Players.
6. Never ridicule or unduly scold a child for making a mistake - positive comments are motivational, negative comments are harmful.
7. Not carry, supply or consume alcohol at any match, except in a licensed and/or designated area
8. Follow the instructions and directions of a ground official or DWSC representative.
9. Follow an instruction to immediately leave a venue at which CCF sanctioned matches, training or other events are being undertaken when asked by a ground official, match official or DWSC representative.

Any Person or Club that does not comply with this Code of Behaviour or who otherwise causes a disturbance may be evicted from a venue and is subject to sanction under the CCF disciplinary policy.

The DWSC Executive Committee remain the right to impose penalties to anyone found in breach of the Code of Conduct or any directives mentioned in this policy.

If you have any concerns about the above or believe someone at the ground is in breach of the Code of Behaviour, please bring this to the attention of the Vested Ground Official.

- All Venues are alcohol free zones during junior games.
- No dogs are allowed on the fields at any time.

Doyalson-Wyee Soccer Club Social Media Policy

Social Media Policy 2019

1. Purpose/Outline

The aim of this social media policy is to uphold the reputation of DWSC, affiliated associations/clubs and the Central Coast Football Association and member clubs.

It is important that the reputation of DWSC and its affiliate members are not tarnished online by those who use social media inappropriately, particularly any content that may reference DWSC.

Social media is a useful tool that offers people the chance to gather in online communities of shared interests and create, share or consume content. Doyalson-Wyee Soccer Club (DWSC) recognises the advantages and benefits of the use of social media to enrich and engage people involved in Football. When someone clearly identifies their association with DWSC, and/or discusses their involvement in the organisation in any type of social media forum, they are expected to behave and express themselves appropriately and in the ways, that are consistent with DWSC stated values and policies.

This policy aims to provide some guiding principles to follow when using social media especially when directly referencing DWSC, affiliated clubs and entities.

2. Scope

2.1 This policy covers all members and of DWSC including: Players, Coaches, Spectators, Office holders, Match Officials, parents and families and any other involved participants. This includes anyone who holds one of the above positions with associated clubs/associations and Member Football Clubs.

2.2 The policy covers all forms of social media, including but not limited to:

- a. The use of any social or business networking website (e.g. Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn)
- b. Content sharing websites that allow the user to share photos and videos (e.g. Instagram, YouTube)
- c. Commenting on blogs
- d. Leaving product or service reviews on retailer sites or customer review sites
- e. Taking part in online votes and polls
- f. Taking part in conversations on public and private web forums
- g. Editing a Wikipedia or Google page

2.3 It is the scope of this policy to include anything posted online where information is shared that might affect DWSC, CCF, members clubs or any participants of the sport in general.

3. Branding and intellectual copyright

3.1 The use of any logo, symbol or other Trademark owned by DWSC, affiliated associations, affiliated clubs or member club must not be used in personal social media in any way that shows disrespect or aims to tarnish the reputation of DWSC and other members.

4. Principles/Usage

4.1 The internet is not anonymous. DWSC, participants should assume that everything posted on the web can be traced back to them.

4.2 When using social media for personal or professional means, all DWSC participants should respect the brand of DWSC, affiliate associations, affiliate clubs and member clubs as well as any other members that participate in our sport.

4.3 All DWSC participants should follow the guidelines in place in order to ensure that the sports intellectual property or its relationship with its stakeholders and sponsors is not tarnished or the organisation is not brought into disrepute.

4.4 For DWSC participants using social media:

- a. Must not contain, or link to, discriminative, defamatory, Bullying or harassing content – this also applies to the use of illustrations or nicknames;
- b. Must not comment on, or publish information that is confidential in anyway;
- c. Must not bring the organisation or the sport into disrepute; or
- d. Must not otherwise be in breach of the DWSC/CCF/ FFA Code of Conduct.

5. Official DWSC Sites, Social Pages and Forums

5.1 When creating a new website, blog, social media page or online forum that is associated with DWSC, affiliate associations, affiliate clubs or member clubs it is important that care is taken in receiving the proper approval to create the page or forum.

5.3 DWSC sites or associated sites must not contain nor link to any sought of indecent material, as well as this all DWSC sites and associated sites should only contain relevant information.

6. Considerations

6.1 Social networking sites allow photographs, videos and comments to be shared with thousands of other users. DWSC participants must recognize/consider that it may not be appropriate to share photographs, videos and comments in this way.

6.3 Any information posted about another person by a DWSC participant must be removed if asked to do so.

6.4 Information about DWSC and its participants/members that contains considerable bias or unproven facts should not be posted/be removed from social media sites, especially if the information aims to tarnish the reputation of DWSC and its members.

7. Breach of Policy

7.1 DWSC will aim to monitor online activity that has any relation to DWSC or the sport. Any detected infringements or breaches of the policy should be immediately reported to DWSC.

7.2 If a breach is detected DWSC reserve the right to take disciplinary action against any participant, club, or other entity that has done so.

7.3 Disciplinary action may include but is not limited to: Written or verbal warning from DWSC, Suspension from footballing activities or any other penalty as scheduled by the Executive Committee.

8. Consultation or Advice

8.1 This policy has been constructed in order to benefit and protect all Participants involved with DWSC anybody who is unsure or finds any part of this policy unclear can contact the club Secretary to seek clarification.
